

## COOKIE MODULES POLICY

Yes, you are right. The "cookie modules policy" sounds a bit pompous for the way we are and work with our customers. So far, **Escape Group** has accustomed you with a new, creative, uninhibited approach. However, we send you this notice because, as of May 25, 2018, a special collection of European regulations, known as Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on the protection of natural persons (General Data Protection Regulation) has become effective. We'll call it GDPR from now on, it's easier that way.

Let's cut to the chase. One of GDPR effects is that every personal data controller who uses websites should inform its visitors in respect of the specifications of that website and, in particular, the cookies used, guiding them thorough the management thereof. **Escapegroup.ro** uses cookie modules to make sure that our website works efficiently and that you will have an OK browsing experience. Please read this policy carefully. If you do not agree with the information included, you have the possibility, at any time, not to use this website, although we would be very sorry to lose your attention and friendship.

But what are cookies? We shall begin by telling you what they are not. Cookies are not viruses. Our cookies do not retain data, such as your name/first name or bank details. Cookies are harmless, they do not contain software or spyware and cannot access the information on user's hard drive. Cookies are small text files, that contain limited amount of information and are downloaded to the device you use by a special server for **escapegroup.ro**. The browser then sends these cookies to **escapegroup.ro** during each subsequent visit, so that it can recognise you and remember things such as user preferences (e.g.: visits or clicks). A list of the cookies used by our website can be obtained by using the tool available on the website <https://cookies.bit-sentinel.com/>. We use the following **categories of cookies**: necessary, statistic and marketing. Let's take them one at a time.

- **necessary cookies** (they make the site functional and allow you, among other things, to browse the escapegroup.ro pages. Without this type of cookie, our website has little chance of working)
- **statistical, analytical or performance cookies** (these are cookies used to help us understand whether the information we offer you are efficient, whether our communication method regarding our services is the best. The analytical cookies also give us the possibility to improve the website operation. For example, we can track how many individual users access this website and how often. This information is used only for statistical purposes and not to personally identify any user. Some of these cookies are managed for us by other companies, however, they are not entitled to use them for purposes other than those set forth above. For example, First Party Cookies: Google Analytics. These cookies are used by Google to compile reports and to help us improve our website. - **marketing cookies** (some of the cookies are managed for us by other companies, but these are not entitled to use the data for purposes other than those mentioned. For example, Third Party Cookies: Facebook. You can find out more about the cookies used by Facebook [here](#)).

**The methods to control the cookie modules** exist and they give you the possibility to customize your browsing experience. However, please remember that eliminating or blocking cookies may have an impact on your user experience. For example, if you choose to disable the necessary cookies, certain parts of this website can no longer be fully accessible. The setting for using cookies is included in the Internet browser. Most Internet Browsers are initially set to automatically accept cookies. However, with the help of your browser you can refuse these cookies or you can reduce them to certain types, which you select in particular.
